1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club of WA hereafter called the Promoter will conduct a Closed to Club Enduro Sprint on Saturday 19th June and on Cross Country on Sunday 20th June 2021 at Karping Road Popanyinning. Participants must be members of the Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club as this is a Closed to Club Event. One event CLUB MEMBERSHIP is available **HERE** or when entering on-line.

These events are both rounds of the T&E MCC Club Off-Road Championship Series. Riders may choose to enter for one day, either Saturday or Sunday, or enter both days.

2. JURISDICTION

The meeting has been authorised by MWA which has issued the MWA Permit Number as displayed at the meeting and is open to holders of current MA National Competition Licences or participants who purchase a one event MA Competition Licence.

The meeting will be held in accordance with the General Competition Rules contained in the 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS), these Supplementary Regulations, T & E MC Club Championship Series Regulations, the event Final Instructions and procedures outlined at the riders briefing. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws, and instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY: The Cross Country and Enduro Sprint events are open to riders who are current financial members of the Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club and hold acurrent Motorcycling Australia Open National Competition Licence or who purchase a one event MA Competition Licence.

Riders who are not a member of this club may purchase either full club membership or a one event club membership online.

4. ELIGIBLE MACHINES:

The event is for solo Enduro / MX motorcycles. Motorcycles **DO NOT** need to be road registered to ride these events. The handlebars must be equipped with a protection pad on the cross bar or the handlebar clamps and securely covered ends. (See 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport)

5. RIDER GRADING:

Riders must carefully select their grade and class on the on-line entry form according to the CLASSES scheduled below. The Promoter reserves the right to re-grade any rider after consultation with the Clerk of Course.

WITHDRAWING FROM EVENT/ENTRY REFUND:

If you need to withdraw your entry from the event this must be done by text to 0437 805 620 to the Race Secretary before Friday 18th June to qualify for a refund minus administration fee. There may be no refund issued for anyone withdrawing from the event after this time.

AWARDS:

Points will be awarded towards the T & E Club Off-Road Championship for riders who are full year financial members. One day Club Membership does not entitle a rider to accumulate T & E Off-Road Championship points and points will not be transferrableif full club membership is purchased after the event has been held.

RIDER SIGN-ON & MACHINE EXAMINATION:

Rider Sign-on and Machine Examination will take place at the Start Area between 9am to 10am on Saturday 19th June and 7.30am to 8.15am Sunday 20th June 2021.

At Machine Examination riders must present an approved helmet for inspection and their bike in a clean and properly silenced condition. Riders must wear the correct race clothing as per the 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (Appendix A).

NOTE: There will be Noise Testing in place and bikes have a Limit of 112dB/A.

PLACE AND TIME OF COMMENCEMENT: The start area is located at 10432 Karping Road Popanyinning, 9.7km south of Pingelly. Directions to the venue will be advised in the final instructions emailed after close of entries. Free Farm Camping will be available at the site on the Saturday night with toilets only provided.

RIDERS' MEETING: A riders' meeting will be held at the start area at 10:15am Saturday 19th June and 8.30am Sunday 20th June 2021.

Saturday Enduro Sprint

There will be a sighting lap of Sprint course, which will be done under the control of a lead rider. First bikes will start sighting laps at 10.30am with competition starting at 11am.

Sunday Cross Country

There will be a sighting lap of Cross Country course, which will be done under the control of a lead rider. First bikes will start sighting laps at 8.45am with competition starting at 9:30am

RIDER INFORMATION: Details of Time Checks, Procedure at Time Checks, Sprint Sections and Signs used will be advised in the final instructions and / or will be displayed at the riders' briefing. Timecards and transponders will be issued at rider sign-on.

STARTING ORDER:

Saturday 19th June, Enduro Sprint starting order will be seeded with faster riders going first in class order of Experts: followed by Veterans and Masters; Clubman and Women's classes. The Clerk of Course reserves the right to reseed riders. Riders will leave the Time Check 3 per minute and enter the test - 1 rider every 15 seconds unless otherwise stated either in the final instructions, at the riders briefing or at the Clerk of Course's discretion.

Sunday 20th June, Cross Country start order will be seeded with the fastest rider starting first. Riders will leave the start area in groups as per seeding and results from day 1 depending on conditions on the day.

Riders will be notified of their rider number at registration. *Numbers will be supplied for riders that do not nominate a race number on online entry registration*. All classes of machines must be presented with a clean front number plate.

Riders who have a motocross bike with a current MWA MX number may apply to use that number. It must be included in the correct section in the on-line entry form.

SMOKING: Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 13.14.20.1 h) provides for exclusion from an Event for Smoking in the Parc Fermé, Working Area, or between the white and yellow flags. In addition competitors and supporters are reminded of a Motorcycling WAby-law which states "Smoking is strictly prohibited in areas where re-fuelling is permitted".

DRUG and ALCOHOL TESTING: To ensure compliance with Motorcycling Australia's Anti-Doping Policy regular Drug Testing **will** be conducted at Motorcycling WA events. (See - MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport) Penalties for non-compliance with the MAAnti-Doping Policy are severe and it is the rider's responsibility to know and adhere to these rules. If any doubts exist over banned Substances, it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline on 1800 020 506.

THE COURSE:

Enduro Sprint: Courses will consist of two enduro style special test courses up to 7km, marked out and suitable for all levels of rider. Time between tests will be generous and allow for adequate rest and recuperation. The Tests will be pre-ridden at the start of the day under lead rider conditions and timed on subsequent sections. There will be only one central Time Check at the main control.

The longest distance between fuel checks will not exceed 7km.

Cross Country: The course will be approximately 18km in length and suitable to all level of riders. Riders will do 2 x 1.5 hour timed motos with a break in between.

ACCOMMODATION & CAMPING: There is free camping at the Start / Finish Area on Saturday night. Toilets only will be supplied.
