1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Denmark Motor Cycle Club Inc. and the Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club of WA hereafter called the Promoter will conduct an **Interclub Cross Country on Saturday 22**nd **April** and **an Interclub Enduro Sprint on Sunday 23**rd **April 2023** at Simpson Road Mt Barker. Participants **must** be members of the following MWA affiliated Clubs: Denmark MCC, T & E MC, Bunbury MC, Collie MC and Cranbrook DMCC. One event T & E MC Club Membership is available **HERE** or when entering on-line.

Riders may choose to enter for one day, either Saturday or Sunday, or enter both days.

2. JURISDICTION

The meeting has been authorised by MWA which has issued the MWA Permit Number as displayed at the meeting and is open to holders of current MA National Competition Licences or participants who purchase a one event MA Competition Licence.

The meeting will be held in accordance with the General Competition Rules contained in the 2023 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS), these Supplementary Regulations, the event Final Instructions and procedures outlined at the riders briefing. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws, and instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY: The Cross Country and Enduro Sprint events are open to riders who are current financial members of the following MWA affiliated Clubs Denmark MCC, T & E MC, Bunbury MC, Collie MC and Cranbrook DMCC and hold a current Motorcycling Australia Open National Competition Licence or who purchase a one event MA Competition Licence.

Riders who are not a member of these clubs may purchase a <u>full club membership</u> or a <u>one event club membership</u> online.

4. ELIGIBLE MACHINES:

The event is for solo Enduro / MX motorcycles. Motorcycles **DO NOT** need to be road registered to ride these events. The handlebars must be equipped with a protection pad on the cross bar or the handlebar clamps and securely covered ends. (See 2023 Manual of Motorcycle Sport)

5. RIDER GRADING:

Riders must **carefully select** their grade and class on the on-line entry form according to the CLASSES scheduled below. The Promoter reserves the right to re-grade any rider after consultation with the Clerk of Course.

WITHDRAWING FROM EVENT/ENTRY REFUND:

If you need to withdraw your entry from the event this must be done by text to 0427 482 437 or the Race Secretary before Friday 14th April to qualify for a refund minus administration fee. There may be no refund issued for anyone withdrawing from the event after this time.

There are no Championship points for this event. Other awards at the discretion of the promoter.

RIDER SIGN-ON & MACHINE EXAMINATION:

Rider Sign-on and Machine Examination will take place at the Start Area between 10.30am & midday on Saturday 22nd and 7.30am to 8.15am Sunday 23rd April 2023.

At Machine Examination riders must present an approved helmet for inspection and their bike in a clean and properly silenced condition. Riders must wear the correct race clothing as per the 2023 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (Appendix A).

NOTE: There will be Noise Testing in place and bikes have a Limit of **112dB/A**.

PLACE AND TIME OF COMMENCEMENT: The start area is located at Pavlovich's, Simpson Road Mt Barker, 40km west of Mt Barker (via Pile Rd). Directions to the venue will be advised in the final instructions emailed after close of entries.

Free bush Camping will be available at the site on the Saturday night with toilets only provided.

RIDERS' MEETING: A riders' meeting will be held at the start area at 12:30pm Saturday 22nd and 8.30am Sunday 23rd April 2023.

Saturday Cross Country

There will be a sighting lap of Cross Country course, which will be done under the control of a lead rider. First bikes will start sighting laps at 12.45pm with competition starting at 1.30pm.

Sunday Sprint

There will be a sighting lap of the Sprint course for riders not competing on Saturday, which will be done under the control of a lead rider. First bikes will start sighting laps at 8.45am with competition starting at 9:30am

RIDER INFORMATION: Details on procedure for Cross Country and Sprint Sections and Signs used will be advised in the final instructions and / or will be displayed at the riders' briefing. Transponders will be issued at rider sign-on.

STARTING ORDER:

Saturday 22nd **April, Cross Country** start order will be seeded with the fastest rider starting first. Riders will leave the start area in groups as per seeding depending on conditions on the day.

Sunday 23rd **April, Enduro Sprint** starting order will be seeded with faster riders going first in class order of Experts: followed by Veterans and Masters; Clubman and Women's classes. The Clerk of Course reserves the right to reseed riders. Riders will leave the Start Area in seeded order and enter the test - 1 rider every 15 seconds unless otherwise stated either in the final instructions, at the riders briefing or at the Clerk of Course's discretion.

Riders will be notified of their rider number at registration. **Numbers will be supplied for riders that do not nominate a race number on online entry registration**. All classes of machines must be presented with a clean front number plate.

Riders who have a motocross bike with a current MWA MX number may apply to use that number. It must be included in the correct section in the on-line entry form.

SMOKING: Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 13.14.20.1 h) provides for exclusion from an Event for Smoking in the Parc Fermé, Working Area, or between the white and yellow flags. In addition, competitors and supporters are reminded of a Motorcycling WA by-law which states, "Smoking is strictly prohibited in refueling areas."

DRUG and ALCOHOL TESTING: To ensure compliance with Motorcycling Australia's Anti-Doping Policy regular Drug Testing **will** be conducted at Motorcycling WA events. (See - MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport) Penalties for noncompliance with the MA Anti-Doping Policy are severe and it is the rider's responsibility to know and adhere to these rules. If any doubts exist over banned Substances, it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline on 1800 020 506.

THE COURSE:

Cross Country: The course will be approximately 18km in length, timed for 3 hours and suitable to all level of riders.

Enduro Sprint: Courses will consist of two enduro style special test courses up to 7km, marked out and suitable for all levels of rider. Time between tests will be generous and allow for adequate rest and recuperation. The Tests may be pre-ridden at the start of the day under lead rider conditions and timed on subsequent sections. All riders will complete both tests before a break, then repeat this cycle until each test is completed 5 times. The longest distance between fuel stops will not exceed 18km.

ACCOMMODATION & CAMPING: There is free bush camping at the Start / Finish Area on Saturday night. Toilets only will be supplied. Other accommodation call Mt Barker Visitor Centre **0898 511 163**
