These supplementary regulations and attached entry form are important documents, which affect your legal rights and obligations. Read these documents carefully and do not sign the ENTRY FORM for this competition unless you are completely satisfied that you understand the contents **and agree to be bound by them.**

• **ANNOUNCEMENT & JURISDICTION**

The Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club, known as the PROMOTER, will conduct the meeting for Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club of WA, ONLY in accordance with the GENERAL COMPETITION RULES OF MOTORCYCLING AUSTRALIA (GCR's), these supplementary regulations & any additions or amendments approved by MWA.

• **OFFICIALS**

Officials are appointed with the approval of MWA. Control will be under the Clerk of Course with the supervision from the Steward/s of the meeting who reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the event program if required, without notice. The Steward is appointed by MWA.

• **ELIGIBLE CLASSES & EVENTS**

• **Classes for 16 and over**

Expert 1 Up to 250cc  
Expert 2 Over 250cc  
Clubman 1 Up to 250cc  
Clubman 2 Over 250cc  
Veterans (35 – 44)  
Masters (45 – 54)  
Womans  
Fossil (55 & over)  
Novice – (this is a non competitive format and will not be timed).

**3.2. Machine Numbering:** Riders will be issued a number at rider registration if you have not nominated a race number with your entry.

- **. Eligible Machines:** Motorcycles do not need to be registered and must be suitable for MX or Enduro racing and meet the Motorcycling GCR's rules.

**3.4. Eligible for TRAIL & ENDURO MOTORCYCLE CLUB members only,** (a one event club membership is available via our website)

**3.5.** A rider may enter 2 classes, however 1 must be headlight class and the machine must have a headlight and represent an enduro motorcycle.

## **4 MINIMUM / MAXIMUM RIDERS**

The maximum number of entries that will be accepted per class is 40 riders

The minimum number of entries to constitute a class is 10 riders. Classes may be altered to suit entries received.

## **5 ENTRY FEES AND CONDITIONS**

### **5.1 Closing Date for Entries**

Entries will close Tuesday 6/8/2019 at midnight

### **5.2 Enter online ONLY at [www.trailandenduro.com.au](http://www.trailandenduro.com.au)**

There will be NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

- **Entry Fees are as follows**

Entry fees:       \$80 per rider per class or                               \$100 per rider for 2 classes

- **MACHINE EXAMINATION**

Pits will open 7:30am. Machine examination from 7.30am to 8:30am.

**All competitors must present themselves at registration with their MA license, proof of current club membership listed on their licence prior to Machine Examination. Helmets and Boots will be inspected at machine examination. Full riding gear will be inspected on start line prior to practice. Any machine not presented with all of the above requirements will be rejected! ALL MACHINES MUST CONFORM TO THE GCR's.**

**No Helmet Cameras as per the GCR's.**

- **RIDERS MEETING**

A riders meeting will be held 8:40. All riders must attend.

- **START METHOD**

Self-penalising drop gates. Clutch start. Gates positions will not be allocated.

Only authorised officials will be permitted on the Start Line

15 second board displayed to all riders for full 15 seconds

1. At the end of 15 sec a 5-sec board will be displayed.
2. The gate will drop between 5 and 10 seconds after the 5-sec board is shown.

- **FINISH METHOD**

A one-lap board will be displayed to the riders indicating when one lap remains. The chequered flag is displayed to signal the race is finished.

- **PROTESTS**

All protests shall be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$70.00 (refer GCR's).

- **THE COURSE**

The course will be approximately 3 - 4km long depending on conditions, It will consist of Natural Terrain grass, jumps, and hills.

- **AWARDS**

**Trophies:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class where ten (10) or more entries are received.

If there are less than 10, then the classes may be combined with the approval of the Clerk of Course.

**Prizes:** All entrants will go into the draw at Presentation for prizes, you must be at presentation to collect

- **FIRST AID**

First Aid personnel will be in attendance.

It is a condition of entry that First Aid **MUST** be accepted wherever deemed necessary by the attending first aides. The Steward of the day has the right to refuse further racing of a rider if first aide requirements are not adhered to.

- **NO HASSLE POLICY**

Any rider or entrant or person associated with the rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. A rider shall be responsible for his own conduct and that of any person with whom he is associated. Anyone who abuses or threatens personally or physically any official or any other person present at the event shall be deemed to be in Breach of this rule.

The Steward for a breach of this rule may impose PENALTIES on the day of this meeting i.e.:

\*Reprimand or warning. \*Fine. \*Expulsion from the meeting. All breaches will be reported to MWA for possible further action.

- **GENERAL RULES**

A. No alcoholic beverages allowed in pits or racing circuit.

B. There will be no riding of bikes other than on the track or designated lane way.

- Machines must be pushed to and from vehicles and in and out of the pits. Engine may be running to assist.

- Dogs will not be permitted (except guide dogs).

- Machines must remain in pits for the duration of the days racing, unless permission has been granted by the Steward to remove the machine.

- Enclosed footwear must be worn in the pits at all times.

- No pit bikes.
