### **1. ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club of WA, will conduct a Closed to Club Natural Terrain Motocross at **816 Burnie Road, Yarloop**.

Participants must be members of the Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club as this is a Closed to Club Event. One event CLUB MEMBERSHIP is available [HERE](#) or when entering on-line.

**This event is both rounds of the T&E MCC Club Off-Road Championship Series.**

### **2. JURISDICTION**

The meeting has been authorised by MWA which has issued the MWA Permit Number as displayed at the meeting and is open to holders of current MA National Competition Licences or participants who purchase a one event MA Competition Licence.

The meeting will be held in accordance with the General Competition Rules contained in the 2022 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS), these Supplementary Regulations, T & E MC Club Championship Series Regulations, the event Final Instructions and procedures outlined at the riders briefing. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws, and instructions.

**3. ELIGIBILITY:** The Natural Terrain event is open to riders who are **current financial members of the Trail and Enduro Motorcycle Club and hold a current Motorcycling Australia Open National Competition Licence or who purchase a one event MA Competition Licence.**

Riders who are not a member of this club may purchase either [full club membership](#) or a [one event club membership](#) online.

### **4. ELIGIBLE MACHINES:**

The event is for solo Enduro / MX motorcycles. Motorcycles **DO NOT** need to be road registered to ride these events. The handlebars must be equipped with a protection pad on the cross bar or the handlebar clamps and securely covered ends. (See 2022 Manual of Motorcycle Sport)

### **5. RIDER GRADING:**

Riders must **carefully select** their grade and class on the on-line entry form according to the CLASSES scheduled below. The Promoter reserves the right to re-grade any rider after consultation with the Clerk of Course.

**AWARDS:**

Points will be awarded towards the T & E Club Off-Road Championship for riders who are full year financial members.

One day Club Membership does not entitle a rider to accumulate T & E Off-Road Championship points and points will not be transferrable if full club membership is purchased after the event has been held. Placing in Headlight class will not go towards T&E Off-Road Championship points.

### **RIDER SIGN-ON & MACHINE EXAMINATION:**

Rider Sign-on and Machine Examination will take place at the Start Area between 7.30am to 8.30am Saturday, 21st May 2022. At Machine Examination riders must present an approved helmet for inspection and their bike in a clean and properly silenced condition. Riders must wear the correct race clothing as per the 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (Appendix A).

**NOTE:** There may be Noise Testing in place and bikes have a Limit of **112dB/A**.

**PLACE AND TIME OF COMMENCEMENT:** The start area is located at Beverley. Full address and directions to the venue will be advised in the final instructions emailed after close of entries.

**RIDERS' MEETING:** A riders' meeting will be held at the start area at 8.45am on Saturday, 21st May 2022.. There will be a sighting lap done in class order under the control of a lead rider with experts starting at 9.10am.

### **START METHOD**

Bungee Start method. Only Authorised officials will be permitted on the Start Line 15 second board displayed to all riders for a full 15 seconds At the end of 15 sec a 5-sec board will be displayed. The bungee will be released at approximately 5 seconds after the 5-sec board is shown.

### **FINISH METHOD**

A one-lap board will be displayed to the riders indicating when one lap remains. The chequered flag is displayed to signal the race is finished.

### **PROTESTS**

All protests shall be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$100.00(refer GCR's).

### **THE COURSE**

The course will be approximately 3 - 4km long depending on conditions, it will consist of Natural Terrain grass, jumps, and hills.

### **RIDER NUMBERS**

Riders will be notified of their rider number at registration. **Numbers will be supplied for riders that do not nominate a race number on online entry registration.** All riders **MUST** have numbers displayed on the front plate and on the left side plate. All classes of machines must be presented with a clean front and left side number plate.

***Riders who have a motocross bike with a current MWA MX number may apply to use that number. It must be included in the correct section in the on-line entry form.***

### **FIRST AID**

First Aid personnel will be in attendance. It is a condition of entry that First Aid MUST be accepted wherever deemed necessary by the attending first aides. The Steward of the day has the right to refuse further racing of a rider if first aide requirements are not adhered to.

### **NO HASSLE POLICY**

Any rider or entrant or person associated with the rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. A rider shall be responsible for his own conduct and that of any person with whom he is associated. Anyone who abuses or threatens personally or physically any official or any other person present at the event shall be deemed to be in Breach of this rule.

The Steward for a breach of this rule may impose PENALTIES on the day of this meeting i.e.: \*Reprimand or warning. \*Fine. \*Expulsion from the meeting. All breaches will be reported to MWA for possible further action.

### **GENERAL RULES**

- A. No alcoholic beverages allowed in the racing circuit.
- B. Bikes being ridden in the pit area must do so at walking speed in first gear only. The Clerk of Course may issue a breach of this rule and impose PENALTIES on the day of this meeting, penalties will range from a warning to a points penalty.
- C. Dogs will not be permitted (except guide dogs).
- D. Enclosed footwear must be always worn in the pits. No pit bikes.

### **SMOKING**

Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 13.14.20.1 h) provides for exclusion from an Event for Smoking in the Parc Fermé, Working Area, or between the white and yellow flags. In addition, competitors and supporters are reminded of a Motorcycling WA by-law which states "Smoking is strictly prohibited in areas where re-fuelling is permitted".

### **DRUG and ALCOHOL TESTING**

To ensure compliance with Motorcycling Australia's Anti-Doping Policy Regular Drug Testing **will** be conducted at Motorcycling WA events. (See - MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport) Penalties for non-compliance with the MA Anti-Doping Policy are severe

and it is the rider's responsibility to know and adhere to these rules. If any doubts exist over banned Substances, it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline on 1800 020 506.
