BY-LAW 5: AVERAGE CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS FOR MAIN EVENT OFFICIALS

(Reference: Constitution Clause 3)

Adopted: Board Meeting - 1st December 2022

- 5.1 When taking on a role as a Key Official at an event, a member may apply to be awarded average points for that event in the Club Championship Series.
- 5.2 The points will be calculated by averaging the points scored for the series in the events in which they competed, and adding this average to the event they officiated at.
- 5.3 The Board will decide which Key Official Roles qualify and may depend on the discipline.
- 5.4 Roles which may Qualify are:-
 - Steward; (automatic qualify as cannot ride under MA Rules)
 - Clerk of Course; (automatic qualify as cannot ride under MA Rules)
 - Assistant Clerk of Course
 - Race Secretary;
 - Assistant Race Secretary
 - Event Coordinator
- 5.5 If the board wishes to alter qualifying officials from those in By-Law 5.4, they must be set prior to the start of the competitive season.
- 5.6 Riders who are under MA /MWA imposed Suspension may not qualify for average points under this By-Law.
- 5.7 Riders who are injured and would not be able to ride the event at which they officiate anyway, will not qualify for average points under this by-law.
- 5.7 Prior to the event, claimants must notify the Race Secretary and/or Board of the intention to claim average points. The board will consider claims notified under exceptional circumstances.
- 5.8 Members will not be eligible for Club Championship Awards unless a bona fide attempt is made to start in at least 50% of the rounds (average points rounds are not included in the 50%.)

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
