Club By-Laws

BY-LAW 9: METHOD OF SCORING POINTS FOR CLUB EVENTS

(Reference: Constitution Clause 3.15)

Adopted: Board Meeting - 1st December 2022

9.1 MX:

- Where there is more than 1 heat the results of each heat will be allocated points using the methods in the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.(Enduro and Reliability Trials)
- Competitors will score points from 1st place through to 20th place as per the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
- To receive points for the event rider must complete a minimum of 50% of eligible heats.
- At the completion of the meeting the points for the heats will be tallied and the riders with the most points declared the winner of each class for the event.
- Competitors will score event points from 1st place (25) through to 20th place (1) as per the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.

9.2 SPRINT:

- Points will be allocated for each heat based on the elapsed times.
- The rider in each class with the least total elapsed time will be declared the winner of the class.
- To be considered a finisher, riders must start all heats and complete at least 66% of the heats.
- A rider who starts but does not complete a heat will be awarded the slowest time of the heat in their class PLUS 50% of the slowest time in their class.

9.3 CROSS COUNTRY:

- Where the Cross Country consists of 1 single race the points will be allocated using the methods in the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.(Enduro and Reliability Trials)
- Where the Cross Country consists of two or more heats on the day, each heat will be allocated points using the methods in the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.(Enduro and Reliability Trials)
- Riders completing less than 50% of the Time /distance of the winner of their class will be classified as Did Not Finish (DNF)
- At the completion of the meeting the points for all heats will be tallied and the riders with the most points declared the winners of each class for the event.
- Competitors will score event points from 1st place (25) through to 20th place (1) as per the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.

9.3 Enduro

- Scored as individual events for each day as per MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
- Competitors will score event points from 1st place (25) through to 20th place (1) as per the Motorcycling Australia Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
